# About the Author ...

## Rodney Hall

Rodney was born in an England still gripped by food rationing and the effects of austerity following the ravages of World War II ... at 18 months of age, he travelled by plane (BOAC Argonaut) via the Middle East and Ceylon to Singapore (a three-day trip with flying only during daylight hours).

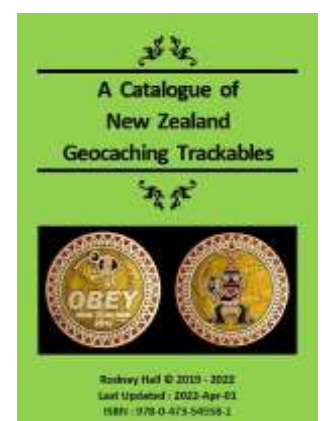
He spent the next 13 years overseas in Malaya, Singapore and finally on the island of Zanzibar in East Africa, and has fond memories of sea, sand, and sun on the beaches there, with boarding school just a plane, train, and bus ride away in Kenya.

It was during these years in East Africa that Rodney started collecting world coins, garnered by his father who travelled extensively around the world as a fisheries scientist.

After returning by ship (the P&O liner Chusan) via Cape Town to England, he could not wait to leave again, and in 1978 with a young family in tow, emigrated to New Zealand.

Tastes change, and Rodney went on to collect world banknotes, New Zealand commemorative medals and currently New Zealand challenge coins.

Along with his interest in New Zealand Challenge Coins, Rodney also collects New Zealand Geocaching Trackables (Geocoins and Pathtags), and Philippine Challenge Coins. His main focus is now on research, and he is actively gathering data for future electronic catalogues in these areas.

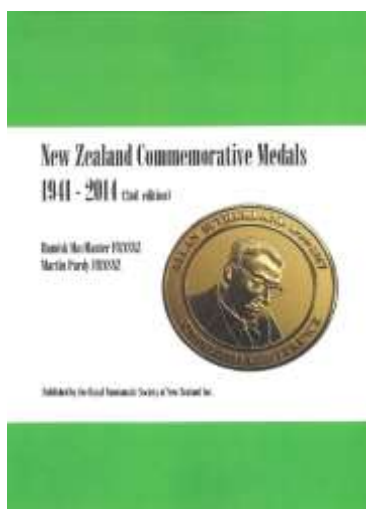

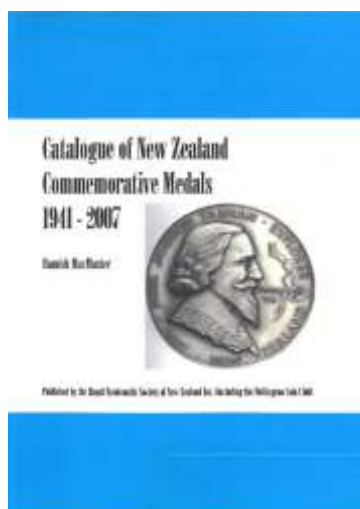

# Glossary of Terms

**Numismatics** (ancient Greek: νομισματική) is the scientific study of money and its history in all its varied forms ... while numismatists are often characterised as studying coins, the discipline also includes the study of banknotes, medals, medallions, tokens, and stock / bond certificates

**Sub-fields or related fields of numismatics are:**

**Exonomia** is the study and collection of coin-like objects such as tokens, **challenge coins**, geocoins, medals, medallions, and other items used in place of legal currency or for commemoration (also known as paranumismatics)







**Notaphily** is the study and collection of paper money or banknotes

**Philately** is the study and collection of postage stamps and other related items

**Scripophily** is the study and collection of stock and bond certificates

Term	Description
Alloy	Homogeneous mixture of two or more elements, where the resulting compound has metallic properties ... common coin alloys include cupro-nickel (copper and nickel) and bronze (copper and tin)
Alloy	Homogeneous mixture of two or more elements, where the resulting compound has metallic properties ... common coin alloys include cupro-nickel (copper and nickel) and bronze (copper and tin)
Annealing	Process of heating and cooling metal in order to relieve stresses ... this is often done with coin blanks to make the metal less brittle before striking
Assay	To analyse and determine the purity of metal
Attribution	Identifier of a coin such as date, mint, denomination, or variety
Bag Mark	Surface mark, or nick, on a coin usually from contact with other coins in bag ... more often seen on large coins ... also called "Contact Mark"
Base Metal	Non-precious metal or alloy containing no gold or silver ... common base metals used in coinage include nickel and copper
Beading	Raised dot border along the rim of a coin
Bi-Metallic	A coin comprised of two different metals, bonded together
Blank	Also refers to the un-struck or flat side of a uniface coin
Blank	Prepared piece of metal on which the coin is struck ... also called a "Planchet" or "Flan"
Brass	Copper based alloy with zinc
Bronze	Copper based alloy with tin
Circulated	Term used to indicate a coin that has wear








Term	Description
Clad Coinage	Coins that have a core and outer layer made of different metals
Coin alignment	A method of striking in which the obverse and reverse dies are aligned 180 degrees from each other
Collar	Outer ring of the die chamber that holds the blank in place while the obverse and reverse are being stamped
Commemorative	A special coin issued to honour an outstanding person, place, or event
Condition	The physical state of a coin
Contact Marks	Minor abrasions on coins created by contact with other coins ... also called “Bag Mark”
Counterfeit	A fake coin made so that people will think it is genuine
Cud	A defect from a chipped die
Denticles	Small toothlike projecting points on the inside edge of coins
Designer	Artist or creator of a coin’s design
Device	Pattern or emblem used in the design of a coin
Die	An engraved stamp used for impressing a design (images, value, and mottoes) upon a blank piece of metal to make a coin
Die Clash	Caused when a coin planchet fails to be placed between two dies during the minting process, causing the dies to smash together ... the design of one or both may impress into the opposite die, causing a “shadow” of the design to appear on subsequent coins minted with the damaged dies ... the impact of the two dies may also result in die cracks or defects
Die Crack	Fine raised line on a coin that was caused by a crack in the die
Die Defect	Imperfection of various sorts caused by a damaged die ... may refer to a crack or clash or a chip out of the die, etc ... a defect from a chipped die is called a cud
Die Marriage	The combination of a particular obverse and reverse set of dies ... if one die is replaced a new die marriage is created
Die State	A variation in appearance to a coin struck by a single die, resulting from wear or alteration of the die ... for example, the presence or absence of die cracks may signal a specific die state
Die Variety	Minor variation in a die, including repunching, doubling, or deliberate minor changes to the die design
Dipped, Dipping	Chemical cleaning of a coin with a diluted acid ... this “cleanliness” is a result of the surface of the coin being dissolved by the acid ... dipped coins almost always have a lower numismatic value than when they were in their former “dirty” state hence most numismatists do not recommend dipping or any other method of cleaning coins as this will reduce the coin’s value
Double strike	A coin where a die is struck, bounced, then struck again, offset from first strike

Term	Description		
Edge -v- Rim	<p>These two terms are often used interchangeably, a trap that we have also previously fallen into ... for this volume we have adopted the following strict distinction</p> <p><b>Edge:</b> The “third side” of a coin or medal, the part that stands vertically when the item is laid flat on either face ... not visible when you look at either face ... see Edge Patterns entry below</p> <p><b>Rim:</b> The raised border around each face of a coin or medal ... visible when you look at either face ... see Rim Patterns entry below</p> <p>The edges of most challenge coins are plain (see Edge Pattern Example entry below), but will occasionally contain a maker’s mark, e.g. “ELM” (see below) or the Platatac symbol (see below) ... the rims take various forms (see Rim Pattern Example entry below) ... we have also noted “Cartwheel type” (aka. BROAD) rims, which are much broader than the other rim types and often contain incuse legends, similar to those on Britain’s copper “cartwheel” coinage of 1797</p>

Effigy	The image or likeness of a person, usually on the obverse of a coin		
Electrotype	Reproduction made by electrodeposition frequently used in museum displays		
Enamel	Addition of coloured hard or soft enamel to one or both sides of a coin		
Engraver	Artist who sculpts a clay model of a coin’s design in bas relief ... or who cuts the image of a design onto a die		
Error	An improperly produced coin, overlooked in production, and later released into circulation		
Essai, Essay	A trial strike ... also a strike intended to evaluate the design		
Exergue	A segment of the coin design separated by a line (usually indicating the ground in the design) in which a legend / date is inscribed		
Fantasy	Generally a privately issued coin not a unit issued coin		
Field	The portion of a coin’s surface not used for design or inscription		
Flan	Prepared piece of metal on which the coin is struck ... also called a “planchet” or “blank”		
Hairlines	Tiny lines or scratches on coins, usually caused by cleaning or polishing		
Hub	Positive-image punch that impresses the coin’s design onto a die

Incuse	Opposite of "Relief" ... the part of a coin's design that is pressed into the surface (intaglio)
Inscription	Lettering and wording on a coin
Legend	Principal inscription on a coin
Lettered Edge	The outside edge of a coin containing an inscription
Low Relief	A coin with the raised design slightly above the field
Master Die	Original die from which working hubs are made
Medal Alignment	A method of striking coins in which both the obverse and reverse dies are aligned in the same direction
Milled Coinage	Machine-struck coinage In contrast to hammered coinage and cast coinage
Milled Edge	Edge of a coin with vertical grooved lines around the perimeter ... also called a "Reeded Edge" ... see Edge Patterns above
Mint	A place where coins of a country are manufactured under government authority
Mint Error	Defective coin produced by a mint
Mint Mark	Small letter (or other symbol) indicating at which mint the coin was struck
Mintage	The quantity of coins produced
Mis-Strike	Off centre striking of a coin
Mule	Coin struck from two dies never intended to be used together
Obsolete	A coin design or type that is no longer produced
Obverse	Opposite of "Reverse" ... front or heads side of coin (often shortened to "Obv")
Off-Center	Describes a coin that has received misaligned strike from the coin press and has portions of its design missing
Over Graded	Coin in worse condition than stated
Overstrike	A new coin produced with a previously struck coin used as the planchet
Patina	Surface film caused by oxidation, usually green or brown, mostly found on older silver, copper, or bronze coins
Pattern	An experimental or trial piece, generally of a new design or metal
Planchet	Prepared piece of metal on which the coin is struck ... also called a "Blank" or "Flan"
Reeded Edge	Edge of a coin with vertical grooved lines around the perimeter ... also called a "Milled Edge" ... see Edge Patterns above
Relief	Opposite of "Incuse" ... part of the coin's design that is raised above the field

Riddler	A machine that screens out blanks (planchets) that are the wrong size or shape

Uncirculated	Coin that has never been used, thus retaining all or most of its original lustre		
Uniface	A coin struck with the design on one side only (the obverse)		
Unique	Item of which only one is known to exist		
Upset	A coin struck on which the obverse and reverse are out of alignment		
Upsetting Mill	A machine that raises the rim on both sides of a blank (planchet)		
Variety	A minor change from the basic design type of a coin		
Zinc	A grey inexpensive metal, usually alloyed with copper to make brass coins

## What Are Geocoins?

A geocoin is a metal or wooden token minted in similar fashion to a medallion, token coin, military challenge coin or wooden nickel, for use in geocaching, specifically as form of a calling card ... the first geocoins were developed by Jon Stanley (aka moun10bike) as a signature item to be placed in caches

Many of these are made to be trackable on various websites to be able to show the movement around the world and visitors to be able to leave comments when they find the coin ... each coin has a unique tracking ID, which can also be used when logging it to a designated website

A geocoin typically has a diameter of 38 mm to 51 mm and a thickness between 2.5 mm and 4 mm. Coins with the size of 25 mm are called microcoins, because they fit into microcaches (e.g. film canister) ... the smallest geocoins with a diameter of 13 mm are called nanocoins and have been sold since 2009 ... if the diameter is larger than 76 mm the geocoin is called macrocoin

### Signature items

Personal geocoins are a personal signature item that normally bears the geocacher's "handle" and personal design. For example, it was Jon Stanley's original manufacture of a coin that started the hobby of geocaching ... it has a stylized mountain bike and his caching handle, and on the back the geocaching logo

Geocoins are often minted by caching organizations and companies ... though not specifically a personal signature item they are a form of signature item for the organization that developed them ... however, most are custom-made for geocachers, usually in batches of 100 pieces or less

Reviewer / Moderator / Lackey Coins are another form of signature items over the years these have their own following ... many of them have taken the time to create their own signature item

In the first few years the number of coins that were a signature item for a geocaching group, or individuals far outnumbered the coins that were made to sell ... however now they tend to be smaller percentage as the industry has a number of coins manufacturers that develop coins for events, holidays, or special coins ... the cost to make a personal coin is fairly high

### Tracking websites

When a cache listed at geocaching.com contains a geocoin, an icon (often unique to the type of the coin) is shown on the cache page's "Inventory" section ... this icon will also appear in the inventory of any cacher holding one as well as in each cacher's historical trackable item listing. Icons will also remain in the inventory of cachers who log the 'discovery' of a geocoin's number without physically removing it from a cache ... "icon collecting" – the act of having these icons listed in one's trackables listing – is an associated hobby ... many people bring geocoins with unique icons to geocaching events so that others may see the coins and use the tracking number to collect the icons online, and it is not uncommon for collectors to activate some or all of the coins in their collections in order to have a matching online collection of icons associated with their geocaching.com accounts

## Theft

It is not uncommon for activated, released geocoins to go missing, whether because a cacher is unfamiliar with the logging and tracking process or due to outright theft ... some geocoin owners will purposefully attempt to destroy the resale value of the coin by drilling and tagging it with an extra tag, marker, or other item that is intended to underscore the fact that the geocoin is meant to travel, not to be kept ... another somewhat controversial anti-theft measure is to create a copy of the geocoin, releasing the copy and keeping the original

In 2012, a geocoin helped authorities return stolen items to a geocaching enthusiast in Seattle, who marked the coins as missing online ... the goods were found in a storage unit during a raid and the geocoins became instrumental in connecting the burglars to their crime

## History

- 2001-Sep-30: The first trackable geocoin released was the Moun10Bike
- 2002-Mar: The first geocoin that was produced and sold to the public to collect and release was the Canadian geocoin
- 2003: The first USA Geocoin was released for sale, making it one of the first geocoins that one can buy, release, and track online without minting an exclusive personal design
- 2005: Geocaching.com permitted any geocaching.com user to obtain tracking numbers for approved designs, fuelling a sudden surge in number of coins ... minimum obtain was initially set at 1000 tracking numbers
- 2006- Fall: Groundspeak reduced the minimum obtain of tracking numbers, and the minimum number of coins minted to obtain a unique icon, to 250 ... the drop in the cost to create a geocoin with a unique icon fuelled a 'geocoin craze' with hundreds of new personal, group and increasingly purely commercial designs minted
- 2007-Feb-17: The First Annual Geocoinfest was held in Temecula, California, USA ... this event brought hundreds of geocoin collectors together for the first time in a mass event, with many exclusive coins being given away or traded
- 2009-Mar-04: Geocaching.com further reduced the minimum number of codes for obtain to 50, and the minimum number of coins eligible for a custom icon to 50

## Coin Finishes

- Antique Finish: A Finish applied to copper, gold, or silver to give it a darker look... this Finish is used often to have the fine details in a coin stand out more clearly
- Foggy Painting: Paint Finish simulating metal applied surface ... can have gloss, shine, or lustre but lacking definition (foggy details)
- Matte: see Satin Finish
- Misty: Silver or gold Finish simulating effect of unpolished areas of a proof coin
- Proof-like: Effect attained on high quality die struck coins by high pressure and multiple strikes producing mirror Finish background with satin Finish relief areas
- Satin Finish: A Finish giving a matte (non-glossy) look to the metal. ... a misused term as traditionally (in fabric) a satin Finish often has a level of gloss associated with it
- Silver: 1. plated with silver 2. .999 solid silver 3. silver-like nickel-plated (shiny nickel)

## Geocaching terms

- Activated/Unactivated: Geocoins with tracking numbers that have been registered on their associated websites are said to be "activated", whereas geocoins that are still unregistered are termed "unactivated" ... activated geocoins that have been left in a cache are meant to be moved from cache to cache like a Travel Bug, whereas unactivated geocoins may be placed in geocaches to be found by others and kept as trophies ... unactivated coins may be also traded or given to other cachers like a calling card, as prizes, as awards, or merely sold and collected
- Custom Icon: 16 \* 16 px or 32 \* 32 px GIF files that are associated to the coin or coin series by geocaching.com trackable coins
- Micro: A geocoin that is smaller than 32 mm in diameter. Generally recognized as a coin that would fit inside a 35mm film canister
- Non-trackable: A geocoin produced without a tracking number
- Personal: A geocoin produced or designed by an individual or team of geocachers featuring team or cacher's nickname ("geonick") prominently on the coin

## What Are Pathtags?

Pathtags are personal trading items. Used most often in Geocaching, they are also very handy for Scouting, Military, and Promotional use. Our online gallery displays many of the thousands of tags which have been designed by individuals and produced by us. This page provides a more detailed introduction to what Pathtags are. There are lots of detailed photos, please be patient while they load. The physical Pathtag integrates with our online community to enable collecting and trading of tags with others from all over the world. To learn about the Pathtags Community, visit the Pathtags Community Tour.



A PATHTAG is a single-sided custom metal tag about the size and weight of a U.S. Quarter or a one Euro coin. The precise dimension of Pathtags are 23mm in diameter and 2.0mm thick. Pathtags are made from a solid iron base and are plated in a protective coloured plating of either silver, gold, copper, or black nickel.

Pathtags are not typically traveling items such as Geocoins or Travel Bugs. They are generally used as personal "signature items" for Geocaching or other trade item. If found, simply log it and the tag's profile will display for you to view. Unless the profile says otherwise, you are welcome to add it into your permanent collection.

There are Pathtags accessories, like the Pathtag Sherpa Geocoin, which turn the Pathtag into a traveling item. In these cases, they are intended to stay with the coin or travel bug to which they are affixed and should be moved along like another traveller.

Pathtags are produced from your own personal design. When you order your Starter Kit, you will be prompted to upload a design from your computer. Pathtags are really easy to design and many owners design their own tags. If you don't feel up to the challenge, check out our Design Page for tips and links to our Design Partners. Design Partners are professionals skilled in the rendering of Pathtag designs. They will help you by producing your design for a nominal fee (typically \$25 or \$35).

The reverse side of the tag is home for your tag's unique serial number. This serial number allows you to enjoy the features of the accompanying online Community. The Pathtags Community is free to access by anyone who finds your tag. As an owner you will have access to all the unique features of the Pathtag Community. These features include a great trading management tool, an online collection tool, and the ability to see who has your tag and where they found it. Each tag has a hole punched in it; this hole serves two functional purposes. First, it allows you to easily display your tags on a peg board (shown below).



Also, the holes enable you to clip tags to collector clips or other storage mechanisms. Some people use ball chains or even shoelaces in a pinch to keep their tags together.

Because Pathtags are made from an iron base, they are also attracted to magnets. This lets you display your collection in a lot of unique ways. Some people buy small round magnets and display them on a fridge, filing cabinet, or white board.



Once you place your order and upload your design, we manage the production for you, keeping you informed as your tag moves through each stage.
